

Please find the Hawaii Citizen's Rights Candidate review in the following pages. The HCR PAC has spent many hours compiling the information about each of the candidates running for office in the upcoming State of Hawaii election. Each candidate is graded on several criteria prior to being assigned their grades.

The first measure is the questionnaire sent out by the PAC to assess the candidate's relationship with the Second Amendment and gun ownership in general. The grades relative to the questionnaire range from an "A" for those strongly in favor of maintaining and improving our gun rights to an "F" for those who seek to diminish American's 2nd. Amendment rights by increasing restrictions on law abiding citizens and gun owners.

The second measure is the known history of the candidate as regards their political positions on our issues, including voting records of elected officials on gun related legislation. Also considered are the lobbying activities of non-legislators who seek improve or damage our Constitutional rights and subsequently seek public office.

Thirdly, we report the NRA Candidate review. The NRA follows a similar grading system as our PAC, including a survey and a review of a Legislators current voting record and a review of their past performance.

Please take this survey to the poles with you and vote for candidates that represent your interests.

Please also note that ALL CITIZENS of Hawaii should be voting for the OHA candidates. This elections is not just for people of Hawaiian ancestry. It is imperative the all citizens get involved with the the OHA election because they control a huge land mass and a huge budget that ALL belongs to the public.
